

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-06 (1142)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAVALLETTE AMENDING CHAPTER 89 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF LAVALLETTE, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lavallette, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section § 89-19 of the Code of the Borough of Lavallette entitled "Schedule III: Time Limited Parking" is hereby amended and supplemented to add a two-hour parking space requirement along a section of Bay Boulevard.

§ 89-19. Schedule III: Time Limit Parking.

In accordance with the provisions of § 89-5, no person shall park a vehicle, for longer than the time limit shown, upon any of the following described streets or parts of street:

Name of Street	Sides	Time Limit	Hours	Location
<u>Bay Boulevard</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>2 hours</u>	<u>7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (during the Lavallette bathing season)</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 38' north of the northerly curblineline of Reese Avenue and extending to a point 20' northerly therefrom</u>

SECTION 2. Section § 89-19 of the Code of the Borough of Lavallette entitled "Schedule III: Time Limited Parking" is hereby amended and supplemented to remove a two-hour parking space requirement along a section of Bay Boulevard.

§ 89-19. Schedule III: Time Limit Parking.

In accordance with the provisions of § 89-5, no person shall park a vehicle, for longer than the time limit shown, upon any of the following described streets or parts of street:

Name of Street	Sides	Time Limit	Hours	Location
Bay Boulevard	East	2 hours	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (during the Lavallette bathing season)	Beginning at a point 38' south of the southerly curblineline of Reese Avenue and extending to a point 20' southerly therefrom

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion

shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after second reading and publication as required by law.




