

**ORDINANCE 2016-11 (1155)**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAVALLETTE, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 7, OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED, "BATHING AND BEACH CONTROL" AMENDING SECTION 7-9 BEACH BADGE FEES**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Lavallette that Chapter 7, § 7-9 Entitled Fees be repealed in part and supplemented in part to read as follows:

**§7-9. Fees for use of beaches and facilities.**

(2) For each daily badge: ~~\$7.~~ \$10.

(3) For each weekly badge: ~~\$25.~~ \$30. A "week" IS DEFINED AS THE PERIOD FROM Saturday through the following Saturday.

(4) For each full-season badge: ~~\$45.~~ \$50.

(5) For each full-season badge:

(a) For any person who is 65 years of age or older: ~~\$14.~~ \$15.

(b) For persons who meet the disability criteria for disability benefits under Title II of the Federal Social Security Act: ~~\$14.~~ \$15.

(c) For all disabled veterans of any military service and all military service personnel on active duty status: ~~\$14.~~ \$15.

(6) For each preseason badge, provided that the badge is purchased during the period of time designated by resolution of the Governing body: ~~\$35.~~ \$40.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Fees set forth above are hereby adopted;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, if any section, paragraph subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, and clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, all ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption, publication and filing according to law.
