Purpose of Event/Eligibility: Lavallette Founders Day is a community event, organized for the purpose of giving back to the community of Lavallette. This event is funded through the efforts of the Lavallette Founders Day Committee members, who solicit donations and contributions from local businesses and various other entities with the purpose of providing an event that will foster unity among the residents of the community, allowing them to celebrate themselves, each other, and the town within which they live. While non-food vendors may be permitted at the event, the Lavallette Founders Day Committee reserves the right to deny any application based on an inconsistency with the purpose and public message intended by this event. Artists and Crafters who submit an application must be offering original work. Applications submitted by vendors offering flea market type goods will be rejected. Any goods and/or services deemed inappropriate by the Committee or its Chair may be removed from participating and/or denied an opportunity to participate.

Rules: Spaces for vendors are 10 feet deep x 12 feet across feet. Vendor is responsible for all display needs. Canopies and Umbrellas are encouraged. Access by vehicle will be limited, and no cars or vans may remain on grounds during the event. Cars/Vans will not be allowed back into vendor area until event is concluded due to pedestrian safety (5:00pm). Designated parking for vendors will be provided. Trash removal, including packaging, is vendor's responsibility. NJ Sales Tax Certificates must be included with your application package, and must be displayed on premise. No electricity is offered to non-food vendors. NO GENERATORS are allowed. Windy conditions may necessitate weights for canopies, please plan accordingly. Pets as guests are not prohibited at this event, be sure to design your display accordingly. Vendor MUST submit photo of goods to be sold along with application form for committee review. Committee will then confirm acceptance to vendor. Checks payable to "Lavallette Founders Day", submit to address above.

Set up time: 8:00am Event officially begins at 11 am.

Breakdown will be done at end of event - 5:00pm (music continues until 8:00pm)

In case of event cancellation prior to start of event due to inclement weather, your prepaid space will be held for the following year's event. No Refunds will be given in the event of cancellation by either party.
