



How the 2011 CAP was calculated:

Chapter 89, Public Laws of 1990 places limits on certain municipal expenditures by placing a CAP on those expenditures. Starting with the total general appropriations in the 2010 budget, certain amounts are added or subtracted as detailed in the above calculation. The result is multiplied by 2.5% or the cost-of-living adjustment (COLA), whichever is less, to arrive at the allowable appropriation increase over the 2010 budget. Chapter 70, Public Laws of 2004 also provides that where the COLA rate is less than 3.5% the municipality may by ordinance increase the CAP to 3.5%.

2011 Property Tax Levy Cap:

NJSA 40A: 4-45.44 through 45.47 establishes a formula that limits the increase in each local unit's amount to be raised by taxation for each annual budget. The tax levy cap is in addition to the existing appropriation cap for municipalities. The core of the formula is a two percent increase to the previous year's amount to be raised by taxation. The formula to calculate the tax levy cap for 2011 is as follows:
