ROUTE 35 RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

On or about Tuesday, December 3<sup>rd</sup> (weather permitting), the NJDOT contractor will begin installing construction barrier curb along Route 35 south for a ¼ mile from Downer Avenue to Carpenter Lane. Traffic will alternate throughout this segment using the northbound lane. Within the closed lane and shoulder the contractor will be installing drainage, water and ITS conduit followed by a full depth reconstruction of the roadway box and pavement. Vehicle access to residential driveways will be limited during this time. This work is scheduled to be completed within 18 days.

Please note that this closure is in addition to the current detour along East Avenue from Johnson Avenue in the Borough of Bay Head to Lyman Street in the Borough of Mantoloking.

Thank you for your patience during this critical infrastructure project.
