FOLLOW THE ORDINANCE

Garbage and trash is not allowed to be placed on the curb until 7p.m. the night prior to designated pick up day.

TAKE A RIDE TO THE DUMP

You can drop off your regular household garbage and trash at the Recycling Center located at the Lavallette Department of Public Works Complex, 120 Washington Avenue.

It is open every day 7:15 a.m. - 2:45 p.m. (except Christmas and New Years)

A CAN ON THE CURB IS BETTER THAN A BAG!

If you are concerned about leaving your garbage can on the curb all week you can always ask a friendly Lavallette neighbor to pull it in for you
